The State Quilt Guild of New Jersey was incorporated in July 1997 exclusively for educational purposes. Our stated goals are as follows:

- To create, stimulate, maintain, and record interest in all matters pertaining to the making, collecting, and preservation of quilts, while promoting educational endeavors through quilts.
- To provide educational opportunities for the community at large through lectures and workshops pertaining to the art and techniques of quilt making.
- To provide a Quilt Show for the purpose of exhibiting quilts, thus perpetuating quilting as an art form in our State.

Membership in the State Quilt Guild of New Jersey will keep you in touch with the quilting community through our quarterly newsletter and seminar-style meetings held twice a year. Meet quilters from around the State, catch up on the news of other local guilds, and find out what they are up to!

Membership in the State Quilt Guild of New Jersey is open to all; individuals as well as local quilt guilds. Individual membership entitles you to receive our “NJ Quilts” quarterly newsletter and to attend all guild meetings. The Membership term is one calendar year from July 1 to June 30.

Membership by a local guild will allow two delegates to attend State Guild meetings so they may share what they learn with their local guild. Local guilds can have their calendar of events printed in the quarterly newsletter. Dates are compiled with other guilds. This will enable you to attend special events at guilds throughout the State. It should also aid in scheduling events such as quilt shows, and in sharing expenses when the “high-roller” speakers are in the area. Benefit from the programs afforded by a membership of over 300.
